Using compost:



Compost your kitchen, yard scraps and garden waste

Reduces the volume of garbage requiring disposal; saves money for you and your community in reduced soil purchases and reduced local disposal costs; and enriches the soil



Bacteria, fungi, molds, worms, insects and other soil organisms will recycle scraps

Plants love compost!
Create a dark brown, crumbly, earthy-smelling soil conditioner called compost
